Information Request

Federal Court of Australia Act 1976

Dear information officer of the Department of the Attorney-General,

Information presents me an anomaly with respect to the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* and its authority to issue Writs in its own name, pursuant to section 37 of the Act in that the Act was passed in a period that the name of the Queen used for purpose of section 58 was not pursuant to the second clause identifying the Sovereign.

I refer to the *First*, and *Final, Constitutional Commission Reports* of 1988 which presents argument and evidence that the *Commonwealth Constitution* does not recognise the *Queen of Australia*, attempted to having been created within the *Royal Style and Titles Act 1973*, which had been used for the purposes of section 58, Royal assent, *Commonwealth Constitution*, since 1973.

Assent, pursuant to section 58, is understood, by the said Reports, to be subject to the second clause preceding the Constitution to identifies the *Queen of United Kingdom* exclusively for the application of section 58.

It is not understood in what manner the *Queen of Australia* may provide for application of section 58, *Commonwealth Constitution*, for bills to become Commonwealth law and believes that all such bills being assented under the *Queen of Australia* are pretended and illegal for application in Australia unless some manner and form of legal instrument demonstrates otherwise.

This request is made in light of the *Constitution* at section 51 which states the condition that the law-making powers are subject to the Constitution which have a precondition of clauses and preamble for which no power exists other than the *Crown of the United Kingdom* and the people of Australia.

I request the instrument, or otherwise information, that demonstrates that the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 complied with section 58 of the *Commonwealth Constitution*, in becoming law, to establish the *Federal Court of Australia*.

I request the instrument, or otherwise information, that demonstrates that the *Federal Court* of Australia Act 1976 complied with section 58 of the Commonwealth Constitution, in becoming law, to establish the authority to issue writs in the name of the *Federal Court of Australia*.

I request the instrument, or otherwise information, that demonstrates that the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 complied with section 58 of the Commonwealth Constitution, in becoming law, to establish the role of the *Chief Executive Officer* for the *Federal Court of Australia*.

I merely seek the instruments, or otherwise information, requested.
