We refer to your email to the AEC this morning.

We acknowledge that some of the posts on GAP's website, Facebook page and YouTube channel have been updated with the required authorisation at the end of the post. However, as set out in our letter to GAP of 23 December 2021, it is the AEC's position that the GAP is continuing to communicate unauthorised electoral matter through its online sites. By way of example, we set out below screenshots of two posts from the GAP Facebook page which constitute electoral matter and which have not been authorised.
