Reminder to Notice of Constitutional Departure Crown in Right of the United Kingdom (WA)

Dear Police Commissioner,

This reminder follows on the notice of September 7 2023 concerning the law, section 2(2) &(3), Constitution Act 1889, for the Crown guarantee by which the authority for the performance of law, and the conduct of justice, relies upon for execution in Western Australia given the State exists by performance and right as a State within the Commonwealth of Australia.

As the said notice required of you to implement an investigation into the matters raised therein as a matter of performance of your office, in oversight of the Police in Western Australia, it is taken that the opportunity, greater than twenty-eight days, you have investigated the issues therein and have not found any reason to deny the same.

As the issues within the said notice have not been demonstrated to be mistaken, misunderstood, or otherwise in error, it now may be taken that the Police in Western Australia is subject to the stated issues and must enforce the said constitutional prohibition in the spirit of the Crown guarantee of our Constitution, that is under the Crown of the United Kingdom.

As of this date, I have not seen nor heard of any material response to the said notice for objection, denial correction or otherwise mistaken understanding and provide this opportunity in the event that it has been overlooked in order to make the record.
